

Spectator's Code of Conduct

Chesterfield Football Club, Chesterfield FC Academy, and the CFC Community Trust are jointly committed to promoting inclusivity in our sport, whilst striving to eliminate abuse and discrimination of any form.

Collectively, we work closely with local and national stakeholders to ensure our stadium is a safe and family-friendly environment for everyone to enjoy.

We will work to identify and address unacceptable behaviour, such as:

- Abusive language
- Threatening or violent behaviour
- Aggression towards our staff, stewards, or volunteers
- Damage to any of our facilities
- Entry into, or throwing items onto the playing area
- Any discriminatory conduct or behaviour, of any type, intended to display, create, or promote hatred or prejudice against individuals or groups based on age, gender, race, religion or belief, sexual orientation, gender identity, or disability
- Conduct likely to bring the Club into disrepute

All identified instances of unacceptable conduct will be challenged. Any conduct or behaviour which constitutes a criminal offence will be reported to Police.

Please remember, intoxication is not an excuse!

Spectators should be aware that failure to observe these Codes of Conduct may result in:

- Refused entry or ejection from the stadium
- Temporary or permanent exclusion from our stadium
- Issuing of an Antisocial Behaviour Contract
- Criminal proceedings
- Football Banning Order issued by the court

These Codes apply to all areas of the SMH Group Stadium, including the CFC Community Trust.

We ask that all our visitors remain mindful of our neighbours when attending the stadium. They are part of our community too!
